



## Spring Fling Film Festival March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2012

### **The Details:**

From February 1<sup>st</sup> to March 23<sup>rd</sup>, submission of finished films in DVD format can be dropped off to Middle of Nowhere Event and Sound at Robot Exchange 111 West B Street or mailed to the same address. A public screening of the films will be held on Friday March 30<sup>th</sup>, at the Union Depot, 132 W. B Street at 8pm. The theme for this years festival is free formed, which means we want to see the creative side of the film makers instead of having them confined to a specific theme, and also films can be made in any genre (comedy, drama, horror, B-movies, etc., excluding explicit sexual content). Films must be in standard DVD format with a maximum length of 12 minutes including final credits. There will be three categories this year to separate the film makers, the Vetrans (those who have submitted to 5 (five) film festivals or more), Newbies (those who have submitted to less than 5 (five) film festivals) and Outies (those who submit from outside of Pueblo) so please indicate which categories you fall into when submitting your film. This year there will be a screening process to determine which films will be shown during the screening, therefore the submission fee is non-refundable if the film is not shown.

Judging will be made by a three (3) person panel. The admission to the film festival will be \$10. Filmmakers plus one will have free entry, regardless of whether film is shown.

### **How to enter:**

Entries can be made by mailing the DVD, entry form and the early registration entry fee of \$15 if mailed before March 9<sup>th</sup> and final registration fee of \$20 by March 23<sup>rd</sup> to 111 West "B" St., Pueblo, CO 81003. Make checks payable to *Middle of Nowhere Event and Sound*. Entry forms can be found at the website [www.moneventandsound.com](http://www.moneventandsound.com).

After the first twenty-five (25) copies, this assignment and transfer will no longer be in existence and this assignment/transfer will cease and all rights transferred hereunder will revert back to the filmmaker/creator. To the extent necessary, "Middle of Nowhere Event and Sound" will sign any transfer/assignment agreement after receiving the first (25) copies of the work at issue. Plus use to use parts of the video for promotional purposes only for this and future film festivals.
